**Study block C- Military Training (Optional)**

**Duration:** Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> – Dec. 6<sup>th</sup> Theoretical approach, (12 weeks, 20 hours); Dec.9<sup>th</sup> - Dec. 13<sup>th</sup> Field Training (1 week, 40 hours)

**Teaching timeframe:** Sep. 3<sup>rd</sup> – Dec 13<sup>th</sup>

**NOTES:** The military training courses consist of lectures on Crisis response operations (20 hours) and Field training exercise (40 hours). They are not accredited and are optional for foreign guests. Together they can be equated to 3 ECTS. Upon satisfactory completion of the Military Training module, LKA undertakes to issue a certificate which indicates that the course has been completed. Necessary equipment will be provided.
